- All fields of research (except medical)
- International partners are welcome to participate, and may also be eligible to receive limited funding

### **ARC Linkage**

#### **Linkage Projects**

- Collaborative projects between HER and other sectors
- Partner organisations must contribute at least 20% of overall project costs (cash or in-kind)
- Linkage Infrastructure, Equipment and Facilities
- Supports cooperative use of research facilities





### **ARC Discovery**

#### **Discovery Projects**

- Blue-sky research in any field
- Funds can be used for access to international facilities
- International Collaboration Awards (ICAs) for Projects to enhance international collaborations





### **ARC fellowships**

#### **Discovery Early Career Researcher Award**

• Early career, AUD130,000pa for 3yrs

#### **Future Fellowships**

• Mid-career, salary plus some costs for 4yrs

#### **Australian Laureate Fellowships**

- For senior research, up to 5yrs
- Funding for staff, project costs, salary supplement





### **ARC Centres of Excellence**

- Significant resources to maintain focus areas on world-class research
- Flexible, long-term funding, can be used to host international researchers





# National Health & Medical Research Council (NHMRC)

- Project grants, partnership grants, fellowships/scholarships
- For all grants, including fellowships, project leaders (CIA) must be Australian citizens or permanent residents
  - Exception: NZ citizens based in Australia

- NHMRC
- Funding to Australian-based researchers only

#### **Cooperative Research Centres (CRC)**

- Supports industry led research partnerships between publicly funded researchers, business and the community to address major long term challenges
  - develop new technologies and products
  - create new markets and export opportunities
  - build capability and capacity for industry through targeted education and training activities
- All fields of research





#### **Cooperative Research Centres (CRC)**

- Co-investment from international organisations is welcome
- Funds (direct costs only) can be spent overseas where justified with benefits to Australia

• Up to 5 years

### Rural R&D Corporations (RDC)

- Joint industry/government funding
- Agriculture, fisheries and forestry
- Funding for travel and exchanges (Aus residents only)

#### **Endeavour Scholarships and Fellowships**

- For incoming & outgoing researchers
- Scholarships for PhDs
- Postdoc fellowships (4-6 months)
- Not all countries eligible, but includes most of the Pacific
