

# Structure of Horizon 2020 financing programme (2014-2020)











- The 28 European Union State members, including their overseas departements
- The Overseas Countries and Territories (OCT) linked to the Member states
- Including the following OTC / PTOM: Anguilla, Aruba, Bermuda, Bonaire, British Virgin Islands, Cayman Islands, Curaçao, Falkland Islands, French Polynesia, Greenland, Montserrat, New Caledonia, Pitcairn Islands, Saba, Saint my, Saint Helena, Saint Pierre and Miquelon, Sint Eustatius, Sint Maarten, Turks and Caicos Islands, Wallis and Futuna..
- The associated countries
- Other countries like : American Samoa, Fiji, Salomon Islands, Tonga,
   Vanuatu, etc ..
- Other countries participants whose contribution to the project is considered to be essential
- A.specific cooperation agreements signed with the EC (ex. USA in Horizon 2020 Health Projects)
- Austalia can take part to the ERC programme







- Research and Innovation Actions: (RIA) = collaborative projects: small (< 10 partners - 1,5M€), medium (4 à 6 M€ ou large (> 15 partners - > 10M€)
- Coordination actions (CSA) < 500 000€
- Individual grants Marie Sklodowska Curie
- Sme targeted research projects (with a share of intellectual property) (4 partners 1M€)
- Excellence: specific grants to finance high qualified researchers « Starting Grant » or « Advanced Grant »





# Health, demographic change, well-being Context of the societal Challenge

- Demographic change
- An increase in the burden of non-communicable diseases
- Rising cost of health care, and pressure on health systems
- Increasing costs of drug development and vaccines
- Lack of evidence on the comparative advantages and effectiveness of current approaches and practices (+ disparity in results)





# Health, demographic change, well-being Ambition of the Societal Challenge

#### A Global Approach

- Horizontal approach based on challenges, which capitalises on integration across disciplines and diseases
- Cover the entire innovation chain from basic research to deployment of products, procedures and services
- Mobilising the potential of information technology for the benefit of health research and care
- Integrate research efforts in a global health policy meeting the European needs
- Boost the development of drugs and vaccines
- Contribute to improving global health





### Structuration of Health programme 2014-2015

Focus sur "personalising health and care": 7 main topics:

- Understanding health, ageing and disease
- Effective health promotion, disease prevention, preparedness and screening
- Improving diagnosis
- Innovative treatments and Technologies
- Advancing Active and Healthy Ageing
- Integrated, sustainable, citizen-centred care
- Improving health information, data exploitation and providing an evidence base for health policies and regulation







# Call Example in the Area: Effective health promotion, disease prevention, preparedness and screening

PHC 7 - 2014 Improving the control of infectious epidemics and foodborne outbreaks through rapid identification of pathogens (closed)

<u>Specific challenge:</u> Human and animal health worldwide is increasingly threatened by potential epidemics caused by existing, new and emerging infectious diseases (including from antimicrobial resistant pathogens), placing a burden on health and veterinary systems, reducing consumer confidence in food, and negatively affecting trade, food chain sustainability and food security.

**Scope**: Sequence based data of pathogens should be generated, stored and analysed in combination with clinical, microbiological, epidemiological, additional gene- and transcriptome-based analyses and other data (e.g.: differing responses in women and men) for risk assessment (RA) in an appropriate information system for all sectors (public health, food, animal health).

#### **Expected Impact** This will provide:

- Better containment and mitigation of epidemics by competent authorities on the basis of a shared information system and global standards for rapid pathogen identification.
- Consequent improved resource efficiency and reduction of economic impact of outbreaks (related to health care costs, market losses); facilitation of international trade, increasing competitiveness of European food and agricultural sector; reinforcement of food chain sustainability and enhancement of food security, reduced carbon footprint.
- Research and innovation action = Collaborative Project
  The CE foresees projects between 10-15 million euros







#### Horizon 2020 was launched in december 2013

The first Work programme covers calls for proposals for 2014-2015.



The work Programme 2016-2017 is under construction The first drafts will be available before mid 2015




