Regional envelop for ACP countries of the Pacific

- 166 millions euros
- FIP is the regional authorising officer
- Pacific « Regional Indicative Program »: 3 priorities for ACP countries :
 - Regional economic integration (50 millions)
 - Sustainable management of natural resources, environment and waste (52 millions)
 - Governance and human rights (15 millions)
- Technical support (3 millions)
- Contribution to regional investments (46 millions)

28 million euros

Public Administration Reform and Governance (access to justice)

Samoa' NIP

20 millions: Water and sanitation

4,5 millions: Renewable energies

Tonga' NIP

11,1million: Renewable energy (+ support to civil society)

Cook Islands' NIP

1,4 million euros: Water and sanitation









National Indicative Program of PNG

184 million euros

Rural Entrepreneurship, Investment and Trade (EUR 85 million)

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (EUR 60 million)

Education (EUR 30 million)

Support measures (EUR 9 million)









Regional envelop for OCTs of the Pacific

36 millions euros (3 times more than 10th EDF) **New Caledonia is the regional authorizing officer**
